### RL Smith

- Installed most of the turf teepads on the short course. Also began digging holes for the baskets on the short course.
- The contractor has finished almost all of the bridges and trails.
- Still need to purchase baskets for the short course.
- Need a few more workdays to finish final touches on the course and prepare for baskets to go in

## Squirrel Lake

- Almost finished with the 18 hole update. 18 poles are set into the ground and are ready to have baskets.
- Pads are framed for teepads.
- Need to have another course workday to help finishing touches.
- Should be ready for a soft opening for the course within a few weeks.

### Bailey Road Park

- New teepad poured on hole 14.
- Richard Barry (Beateys Ford Road)
  - o 9-hole course going in.

# [Signage, Robert]

- Signage Has been installed at Hornets Nest
  - Started putting out the QR codes for how to get involved with the CDGC.
    - Around 130 scans within 2 weeks.
    - Unable to tell exactly who is scanning but we are able to tell where they are scanning from (However, they will all say Charlotte or Huntersville)
- I gathered a few people interested in helping with creating a Signage committee. This is still very new and I won't make the committee official until I can meet with them.
- Cory is working on Richard Barry, Squirrel Lake, and Blair Mill.
- Bobcat is interested in buying blank sponsorship signs and just using vinyl to put the sponsorship names on it.

- This could cut down on the costs of ordering signs one by one.
- The Club could provide funds for Vinyl.

## [CAC Committee, Kyle]

- CAC was successful, and so far, we have experienced positive feedback.
- Players were delivered an awesome experience and a player pack that was appropriately valued
- Had a jump in attendance from 205 to 250 in a one-year period, in a time period when overall we are experiencing a decrease in tournament participation.
- A survey is being spearheaded by Devin to ask for feedback from players to see what they want to see going forward.
  - Melissa suggests that we go ahead and start talking about the CAC for next year.
    Starting with a board-only meeting to explore options for the future.
  - Ozzie suggests having a project manager to help delegate tasks for everyone to do.

  - Thoughts on opening up the CAC to a bidding process. The board will discuss and follow up.

  - Ozzie will lead the charge
- New hole 1 signage at Killy.

  - o Also, TDs need to be shouted out as well.
